The plants were displayed on the tables and throughout the room at her memorial luncheon. Betsy's love of plants, especially California natives and water-wise plants, was well-known. Following the memorial, on Wednesday, March 20, there was a "Morning In The Garden In Remembrance of Betsy" planting event. The plants from the memorial were planted at Casa Romantica and Park Semper Fi by members of the Garden Club. Also in attendance were Betsy's husband, Greg Dunn, and Julie Strauss, Betsy's daughter, who is also a member of SCGC.

We are all aware of the devastation that occurred last April at Casa Romantica. Although the Children's Garden and the Storybook Circle were not involved, the sprinklers on the property were turned off and that area of the property was off limits to everyone. This past fall when we were able to access that area of the property, we were met with the loss of a majority of the plants due to lack of irrigation.

The following Wednesday, on our planting day, the plants purchased by the San Clemente Garden Club were used to help restore the Children's Garden and Story Book Circle. We know with utmost certainty, this is something Betsy would have totally supported.

So, in August of 2024, when the property fully reopens, I encourage you to pay a visit to Betsy's Garden. I know, I know, it's the Children's Garden, but to me, as I'm working in the gardens at Casa, from now on it's always going to be Betsy's Garden.
