Milkweed from Weej Baggaley, Teresa Whitney and Diane Riopka

Milkweed... so many varieties, so much confusion! Aesclipias fascicularis or California native milkweed (pictured below) is a native milkweed that provides crucial habitat for Monarch butterflies. Aesclipias curassavica, or tropical milkweed, is a non-native that also provides food and habitat for Monarchs but can be lethal to them. The big difference is the tropical milkweed blooms throughout the winter and can harbor a protozoan parasite that decreases the butterfly's ability to fly, migrate and mate successfully. Removing all tropical milkweed from your landscape and replacing it with native species is highly recommended. However, if you are madly in love with the tropical, then commit to pruning the plants to 6-inch stems and removing all leaves from November through February.
